Dear FISIER member

The time has come again to request subscriptions to the FISIER for the current year. In the course of the past twelve months, a number of the projects planned by the Association have progressed. We continue to develop the website and to send out newsletters; we once again organised a session at the Renaissance Society of America conference in Washington DC this March on 'Humanist literary circles and salons in the Renaissance'; the publication of the *Intime du droit* conference proceedings is nearing its conclusion; and the colloquium on Renaissance Libraries and Collections, to be held at Clare College, Cambridge, 17-19 September 2012, is at an advanced state of planning, with sessions organised by different member organisations to be devoted to the libraries of Rabelais and Montaigne (coordinated by Claude La Charité and Philip Ford), 'Bibliothèques en feu' (Rosanna Gorris-Camos); the Encyclopaedic Library (Ingrid De Smet); and library architecture and organisation (John O'Brien).

We are also planning to arrange sessions at the RSA meeting in San Diego, California next year, 4-6 April. It was decided at the FISIER AGM, held in January 2012 at the Institut de recherche et d'histoire des textes in Paris, to choose the theme of Sea monsters for this meeting, but the success of the session devoted to Humanist literary circles and salons in the Renaissance has encouraged us to extend this theme in addition to the sea monsters theme for a second year. Anyone wishing to present a paper on either topic should send me by 10 June 2012 (at pjfz@cam.ac.uk) the following elements: author's name, email, and affiliation; paper title; abstract (150-word maximum); keywords; and a brief curriculum vitae (no longer than one page, about 300 words).

In order to maintain and further develop what we are doing, we do, of course, rely on our member organisations' annual subscriptions, hence this reminder. We very much hope that, through your subscriptions, you will help us to continue with our work.
